Challenge

A sensitive development was required when Scotmid decided to take over a formerly empty high street retail unit and convert it into a funeral directors' office.

Mood lighting, muted colours and tactile materials would require to be utilised in order to achieve the desired result – a warm and welcoming place for the recently bereaved to plan their farewells to their loved ones.

Approach

Liaison with the client's management team was key, as was Pacific's experience of delivering other similar projects for Scotmid.
