Challenge

Pacific had to refurbish a hugely popular city centre bar for Mitchells Butlers plc, the UK's leading operators of pubs and restaurants, whose extensive stable of brand names include All Bar One, O'Neill's, Browns and Harvester.

Due to the popularity of The Auctioneers, on North Court, near George Square, business down-time had to be kept to an absolute minimum – so a three-week programme of works was agreed with a two-week closure during that period.

Approach

Liaison with stakeholders, suppliers, architects and sub-contractors was key as Pacific drew on their vast experience of delivering to deadline and to budget in tight, public-realm spaces where access can be problematic. The project was commenced towards the end of February, 2019, and was handed over to the clients right on schedule.

Tight management of the contract meant that The Auctioneers was able to pick up where it left off prior to refurbishment, delivering a high quality, value-for-money drinking and dining experience to customers in a busy location and in an environment boasting high-quality fittings and other impressive features.
