Challenge

Pacific secured the project to fit out a Crew Room for rapidly expanding airline Jet 2 at their base at Glasgow International Airport. The base had to function as an office, a kitchen and staff room all at once in order to meet the requirements of the airline.

Approach

As is always the case with commissions like these, Pacific drew on their vast experience of successfully delivering projects in security-sensitive airport environments where disruption to the busy day-to-day routines, including passenger movements, has to be kept to an absolute minimum. The Jet 2 Crew Room – which occupies a commanding position overlooking some of the aircraft stands at Glasgow – is light, airy, welcoming and, above all, functional. The room boasts extensive seating, tables, a confidential meeting space-cum office and a kitchen area. Large windows running the length of the room help to accentuate the sense of space as well as providing excellent views of the aircraft movements outside.
